- Have a specific health-related condition that may require emergency medical attention;
- Need to bring items into the examination room that are usually prohibited pursuant to the board's Exam Security Procedures and Code of Conduct, but are required due to a health-related condition, such as medication (over-the-counter or prescription), diabetic supplies, lumbar support, food/juice, lactation pump, etc.; and/or
- Need special seating arrangements due to a health-related concern.

Complete this form to notify the board of:

- The nature of the condition;
- The name and telephone number (with area code) of one or more persons who should be contacted in the event of a medical emergency; and
- Items needed in the examination room because of a health-related condition.

If the need is for food/juice, medication, an assistive device, or special seating, a statement from a medical professional verifying your condition and supporting your need must be included.

This form must be filed for each examination and received in the board's office no later than **January 1** for the February bar exam or **June 1** for the July exam. If a health-related condition arises after this deadline, notify MBLE and submit the forms as soon as possible before the exam date. If approved, you will be advised by a message or letter on your MBLE user homepage.
